

TOXIC FUMES UPDATE

24th March 2015

Following recent meetings with members, international union federations and campaign groups on Aerotoxic Syndrome, BASSA have worked with Unite to deliver a dedicated legal service covering such cases. This will involve the launch of a 'register' where crew members can log and record their exposure 'fume' events as well as an accompanying dedicated legal helpline for pursuing legal claims that may arise from any exposure. Passengers can report being in a fume event too:
